## THE PHOENIX COLLEGE

## **Design proposals**



The proposed development includes:

- **1.** A large open space of 170 m<sup>2</sup> with a reception, seating area, tea kitchen and circulation areas.
- 2. Two new classrooms, both of approximately 40 m<sup>2</sup>, and a kitchen classroom of 26 m<sup>2</sup>. Kitchen extract positions match the originally consented commercial kitchen positions.
- **3.** Seating area and study space on the existing mezzanine where students can meet up or sit and work.
- **4.** Existing WC's are retained.

- 5. Students would access the site on foot only. Any vehicles would use the public car parks near by for drop off and pick up, with college staff assisting with getting students to and from the car parks as necessary.
- 6. The students would use the main entrance to the Old Gaol and would have access to sit in the rear walled garden or seating out side the front entrance. There would be no play equipment or out door games on-site, and the students would be taken to use ameni ties at other schools or leisure facilities off site.
- 7. Phoenix College is keen for the site to be a real community hub allowing different local groups to use the College's facilities during the evenings and the holiday periods. The site would be open for students from 8am until 4pm Monday to Friday.
